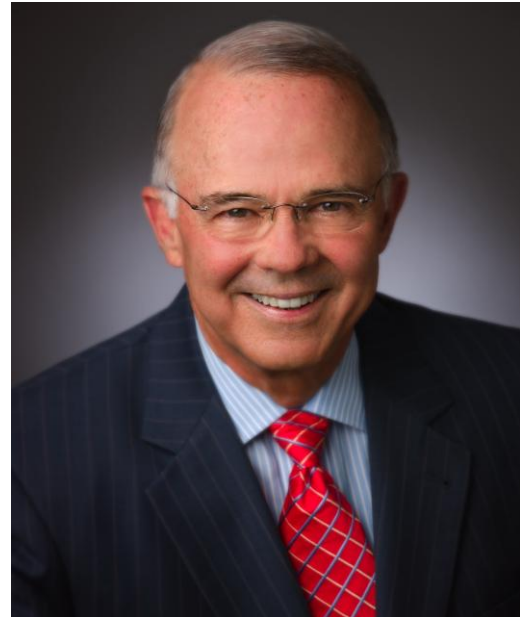


## Stanley B. Goss - Managing Director
